YEAR 10 into YEAR 11 Senior Studies Subject Selection Information Evening

Over the first few weeks of Term 3, Year 10 students are being asked to work through a planning process to determine their educational pathways for the future. For many students this means making decisions about the subjects to study to gain a Higher School Certificate. The guidelines for eligibility to gain the HSC can be complex, so Coffs Harbour High School staff will be assisting you and your child with a range of activities and key dates.

INFORMATION EVENING AND COURSE EXPO

All parents/guardians are invited with their Year 10 students to attend the Year 10 into Year 11 Information Evening. This will be held in the Coffs Harbour High School Hall **on Tuesday 26th July commencing at 5.00pm**. The purpose of this evening is to inform parents/guardians and Year 10 students of the curriculum choices available at Coffs Harbour High School for Year 11, 2023. Information given will explain the Department of Education and Training and NSW Educational Standards Authority (NESA) requirements in Years 11 and 12, Pathways, Vocational Education and Training Courses (VET), Traineeships and Apprenticeships and TAFE options.
