- RoSA** Record of Student Achievement – Cumulative record of results Yr 10 -12
- BDC** Board Developed Courses – ATAR contributing courses. Category A and B courses available
- BEC** Board Endorsed Courses
- VET** Vocational Education and Training (eg Cert I, II, III, IV etc)
- TVET** TAFE delivered VET courses
- UAC / QTAC/ SATAC** University application centres

QUALIFYING FOR AN ATAR

- ATAR = Australian Tertiary Admission Rank
- An ATAR is required if a student is considering applying for University after HSC completion
- 12 units of Board Developed Courses in Year 11 and 10 units in Year 12
- At least 4 subject areas
- Calculated on best 2 units of English and best 8 other units in Year 12 courses
- No more than 2 Units of Category B Board Developed courses

QUALIFYING FOR THE HSC

Year 11 = 12 units (6 courses)

Year 12 = 10 units (5 courses)

Both the Year 11 and Year 12 Courses must include:

- At least 6 units of Board Developed Courses inc English
- At least 3 courses of 2 units value or greater
- At least 4 subjects (including English)
- At most, 6 units of courses in Science can count towards HSC eligibility
- Only one Industrial Technology course can be selected
- Students must satisfactorily complete the Year 11 course before commencing the corresponding Year 12 course



QUALIFYING FOR THE HSC

NESA HSC Minimum Standards

- Students must also meet the minimum Level 3 benchmark in Numeracy, Reading and Writing of HSC Minimum Standards by the end of Year 12 to successfully obtain their HSC.
- Student are offered a minimum of two opportunities per year from Year 10 to Year 12 to sit each of the tests to meet the standards. Once students have met the standard for each section, they are not required to re sit the tests.
- Each test can only be sat online via the school within designated timeframes.

Additional Course Opportunities

- **TVET COURSES**

- Delivered Tuesday, Wednesday or Fridays (each course varies)
- Courses start and finish times vary for each course. Some courses finish at 5pm
- Transport is parent responsibility
- Delivered at CHEC or Glenreagh St Campus
- TVET1 courses are delivered the same time as courses on Line 5 for our school

- Our school will consider applications for DE for other courses delivered at our school should there be a clash in a students course preferences on our lines



School Based Apprenticeship or Traineeships (SbAT)

- SBATs are available to all Year 10, 11 and 12 high school students in NSW. They allow students to commence an apprenticeship or complete a traineeship while at school.
- A school-based apprenticeship or traineeship combines paid work, training and school; and as well as an industry recognised national qualification you will gain credit towards the HSC.
- Students usually combine school studies with VET training and paid employment.
- Some places are advertised at school however most success comes from individuals who source them independently
- A wide variety of industry careers available.
- Students must commence a SbAT by no later than May in Year 11

Instructions on completing Subject Selections online

Step 1: Prepare

Use the 'Year 11 Course Subjects list and Activity Sheet' as a guide to select subjects

Step 2 : Research

Ask questions about courses, review university prerequisites and gather as much knowledge as possible. Further information also available on the school and careers websites

Step 3 : Connect

To select your course preferences, log into your school student portal and go to your school email account. Find the email from the school from Wednesday **July 27th 2022** called '*WebChoice 2023*' open it and select subjects using the unique webcode. **Do not share codes between friends! Subjects are not determined on first-in first-served basis**

Step 4 : Select

Select subjects you want, in order of your PREFERENCE (Important), using the drop down boxes. Students to select 6 main choices and three backup choices. Selections are to be submitted by **Monday 1st August 2022 – 6pm**

Step 4 : Submit Don't forget to press **Submit** after selecting subjects!
