

Non-Local Enrolments

Coffs Harbour High School currently has an enrolment ceiling set by the Department of Education, based on the number of available classroom spaces at the school. Every school is required to set an enrolment buffer to allow enough spare places to enrol any local students starting later in the year. As such, the school is required to decline non-local enrolments unless they need to occur for special and unique circumstances. These circumstances include

- Medical reasons
- Disability
- Siblings already enrolled at the school
- Exceptional circumstances
- Availability of subjects (senior students only)

Only exceptional cases that meet these criteria can be considered by the school enrolment placement panel. When considering an application to enrol, the panel will consider whether any exceptional circumstances / needs can be met elsewhere at the student's local school.
