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### FROM THE PRINCIPAL

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I would like to start this newsletter from a more positive perspective. While there are a number of matters I will discuss later which may seem to be focusing more on the negative, there really are a lot of fantastic things going on at our school. When I am asked about this, I refer parents not just to newsletters such as this one, which are usually filled with pictures and stories about all the great things happening at school, but I also refer them to our school Facebook page. Our Facebook page is filled with loads of pictures and short stories celebrating the enormous range of experiences and achievements of our students. I have always held the belief that, as a Principal, I need to be open and honest with all my staff, students and parents. I don't shy away from the challenges that we face as a public school servicing a complex and diverse community. We do our best to deal with these challenges by acknowledging them, not pretending they don't exist, and then setting about to address and overcome any obstacles in our way. I approach the enormous responsibility of being a school principal from the position of always doing my best and doing what is right, not just what might be easy or popular. I know that not everything we do will please all our students or parents but that doesn't prevent us from doing what is right and is needed so long as we always act in the interests of the education and wellbeing of our students. The end result is that I am proud of our school and the opportunities we provide to our students. As a parent whose children both attended Coffs Harbour High School I am effectively putting my money where my mouth is. I had every confidence in the school and what it could provide for my children and I am extremely happy with where this education has led them as they move on into careers post-school. We have a fantastic and dedicated team here and despite the ups and downs and challenges that all schools face, we continue to work to our best to provide the best learning environment we can for our students. It is all too easy to focus on the few negatives that are evident in any service that involves so many people and complexity, rather than focus on the greater number of positive experiences and outcomes. I ask that if you hear stories and rumours that portray the

school in a negative manner then please challenge them, check that they are not just rumours or individual opinions rather than fact and refer people to our Facebook page or share with them your own positive experiences as parents and carers. If you feel there is something we can do better then please get involved with our P&C and provide this feedback when the opportunities arise so that we can all work together to keep Coffs Harbour High School a great school.

### **Minimal Supervision**

As I have forecast previously, moving into Term 4 we have seen a significant lessening of the shortfall in casual teachers and a greater capacity for us to cover the classes of absent staff. Throughout Term 2 and the earlier part of Term 3 this year, I was open and transparent with parents regarding the issue of the current teacher shortage and the impact it was having on our school. I know that not all schools chose to take this position, and so this may have given the impression that it was an issue only impacting our school alone. However, the NSW Department of Education has recently released data, collected from a survey of all NSW public schools, showing the true extent of this issue across all schools, including:

- NSW schools had an average casual teacher shortfall of 42% per day across the survey window.
- This equates to an average gap of 3,184 casual teachers each day.
- 87% of all schools reported a shortage of casual teachers.
- These 87% of schools were unable to engage enough casual teachers to cover all absent colleagues. Shortfalls were greatest in non-metropolitan areas of NSW.
- Some geographic areas and individual schools were more greatly affected by casual teacher shortfalls, and experienced greater lesson disruption, including at twice or three times the state average.

Regardless of the reasons for this shortage I am conscious of the fact that parents and carers, quite rightly, have concerns regarding the impact on their child's education. Moving forward, I can assure you that we have taken measures to secure additional temporary teachers for next year and ensure the school is fully staffed. However, the situation is fluid as people's circumstances can change and this can impact either the number of staff taking leave or the number of people available to cover this leave. The statewide shortage of teachers (it is actually a nationwide and worldwide shortage) is not something which is going to be immediately resolved, especially given the lead time required to train and recruit new teachers. However, we have taken steps as a school to get on top of this as best as we can moving into next year and I am confident we can mitigate the future impact on our school.

### **Fencing and Security**

As we move into better weather in summer there has been an increasing number of people frequenting the Jetty area and shopping strip and the area around our oval and the school. This has included young people from other schools, as well as some of our students who are either truanting school or have not attended school for the day, unfortunately, sometimes with the permission of their parent/carer. There is also an increasing number of homeless people living in the area, something which is becoming increasingly evident in several major towns/cities on the North Coast. Accordingly, we have had an increased number of incidents involving intruders on our school site, including our school oval. This is an issue the school has been dealing with for some time and I have been trying for some time to have the Department of Education ensure the school is properly fenced and secured. I am now happy to report that, following a great deal of advocacy and lobbying, we have now finally been selected to have our school fully fenced. This will include both the main school site and our school oval. There is a process that needs to be conducted around gaining development approval and tendering, but I have been assured that this is all happening now as quickly as possible in order to expedite the construction of the fence. This is fantastic news, and it will greatly assist the school in maintaining a safe and interruption free learning environment.

## **Attendance requirements**

As we near the end of the year I wanted to reiterate expectations around student attendance. It is expected that every student attends every day the school is open for students. In the last two weeks of school, we will hold presentation and rewards assemblies as well as our attendance and rewards excursions and our end of year activities day. Aside from these days, all other school days are normal days of learning and there is an expectation that all students attend school on all school days. Attendance at school is mandatory under the Education Act and so it is not acceptable for children to be given permission by a parent/carer not to attend school for the day for reasons other than illness or to attend appointments such as medical or dental appointments that cannot be scheduled outside of school time. Parents and carers must also understand that when they give permission for their child not to attend school then they are effectively taking on responsibility for the care and supervision of their child during this time. It is not acceptable to give permission for a child not to attend school, but then allow them to roam the streets or even catch buses into school so that they can spend the day at the beach, for example. We are working with other schools, the Home School Liaison Officer and Police to conduct some truancy patrols in the Jetty area before the end of term. Where we find students who should be at school, we will be returning them to school to be dealt with appropriately. Where we find children not in attendance with parental supervision, we will be making contact and refer them back to their parents/carers. Wherever we have complaints regarding students not attending school causing issues anywhere in the Jetty precinct, we will be referring shopkeepers and the public to contact NSW Police if they have concerns. I cannot stress enough that students are either at school or they are in your direct care as a parent/carer. Your support in reinforcing these expectations with your child would be greatly appreciated.

## **Phones and Yondr pouches**

I have previously mentioned our rules and procedures regarding mobile phones at school now that all NSW public schools are required to implement a statewide ban on these devices. Our process in relation to mobile phones at school is best summarised as “Off and away during the day”, meaning that phones (and EarPods/headphones/smart watches) should be in a student’s bag and off/on silent from 9:10 am to 3:10 pm every day. Most of our students have been handling these requirements without issue and we have very few of these students relying on the use of the Yondr pouches to manage their phones, which is fantastic from the point of view of students developing self-discipline and responsibility. For these reasons, we will be ceasing our arrangement with Yondr at the end of this year and will not be issuing phone pouches to students. We will also be asking for students who have been issued with a phone pouch to return this pouch to the front office prior to the end of the year, so we can pass these back to Yondr as we exit the program.



## CHECK-IN ASSESSMENT FOR YEARS 7, 8 AND 9

Check-in assessment for Years 7, 8 and 9

During Term Four students in Years 7, 8 and 9 will participate in the Check-in assessment. The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online literacy and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning.

The assessment can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs. Students with disability may receive the same level of support during the assessment they would normally receive in the classroom.

- The assessment will be scheduled for our Year 7, 8 and 9 students during Weeks 5, 6 and 7.
- All students complete a reading assessment and a numeracy assessment





# Rural and regional school travel

Apply online for free school travel in rural and regional NSW. You only need to complete one form, even for journeys using more than one operator.

## Who can apply?

To be eligible for free school travel, students may need to live a minimum distance from their school:

### Years K-2 (Infants)

There is no minimum distance.

### Years 3-6 (Primary)

More than 1.6km straight line distance or at least 2.3km walking.

### Years 7-12 (Secondary)

More than 2.0km straight line distance or at least 2.9km walking.

## Who needs to apply

You only need to apply if the student has never been approved for free school travel before. Students in a shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody) should submit a separate application for both addresses.

## How to update your details

You need to update student details online if the student is changing their name, address, school or campus, or their Transport operator. You can update them at [transportnsw.info/ssts-update](https://transportnsw.info/ssts-update)

## Frequently asked questions

**Does the approved free travel include travel outside school hours?**

Approved free school travel is only for travel to and from school. So for travel after hours, on weekends or during school holidays, students will need to buy a ticket.

**What if there's no public transport in my area?**

In areas where there is no public transport, you may be able to get a subsidy for driving the student to school. For details, visit [transportnsw.info/school-students](https://transportnsw.info/school-students)

**How do I apply if the student needs to travel from two addresses because the parents live separately?**

Each parent (or the student if aged 16 or over) needs to apply separately for each address. The same minimum distances apply.

## How to apply for free travel for the first time

You can apply for free school travel for next year from the start of Term 4 this year.

### Step 1

Once you have enrolled your child at the new school, apply online by giving your home address and telling us which bus company the student needs to travel with between home and school. You can apply online at [transportnsw.info/school-students](https://transportnsw.info/school-students)

### Step 2

The school then confirms to us that your details are correct.

### Step 3

We will then work on your application. You will get an email confirming if the student is approved for free travel. If so, we will tell your local bus company who may send a school travel pass (if needed) to your school or, in some cases, the bus company will contact you directly about travel arrangements.

A parent or guardian must apply for students aged 15 years and under. Students who are 16 years and over must apply for themselves.
